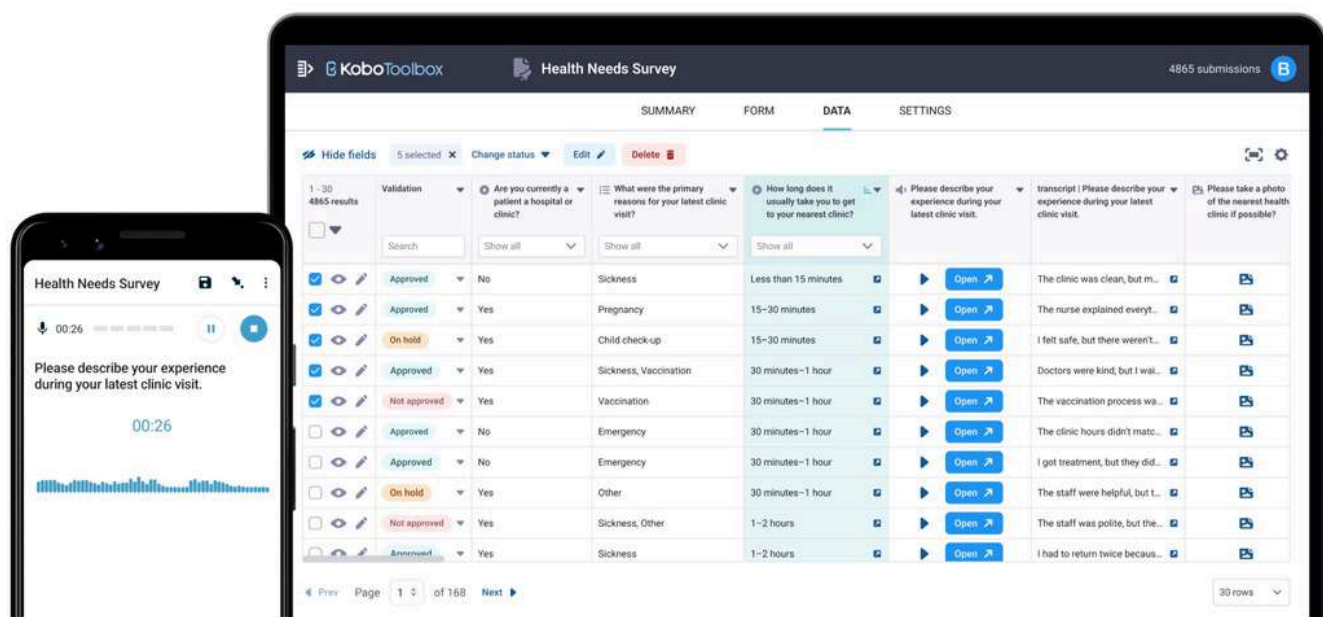

It enables offline-capable, customizable data collection through user-friendly forms, supporting incident reporting, surveys, and assessments even in low-connectivity areas.
